To participate in a fully online course, <u>you need</u> :	
☐ A	Your own email account (you will receive course login information by email) A reliable internet connection (WiFi or Ethernet) A reliable laptop or a desktop computer with a functioning webcam and microphone

- Our videoconferencing and e-activities do not work reliably on a phone or tablet/iPad. For this reason, <u>learners who only have a phone or tablet/iPad cannot be enrolled in a fully online course</u> at the moment.
- If <u>at any time during the class</u> it is determined that a learner cannot participate fully because they do not meet the minimum tech requirements, the learner will be removed from the class and placed on a waitlist for a hybrid (partly online) or face-to-face class.
