eCLASS ONLINE LEARNING

eClass courses are offered through Brightspace by D2L. Asynchronous learning does not occur in real time. Students engage with course content, lessons, and evaluations through the virtual learning platform. Although classroom activities may not happen simultaneously, this structure still promotes the discussion of ideas, responses, and feedback with the class. Teacher's feedback does not happen simultaneously. Students are expected to login each school day. eClass is available to adult learners and current students.

TYPES OF COURSES OFFERED

NEW CREDIT COURSES

Open to all high school students and adults with the appropriate pre-requisites, students may take new credit, or re-take a course previously taken to upgrade a mark.

Students may register for a **maximum total of two new credit courses** this summer or a combination of two upgrading courses during session 1 and one new credit course in session 2.

*** Please note:** You must have earned the credit for any prerequisite course (if applicable) to apply for a new credit course.

UPGRADING COURSES

These courses enable students to obtain one full credit by repeating 55 hours of instruction. Students must have a minimum mark of 35%. Students may register for a maximum of two upgrading credit courses this summer during session one in-person and/or remote learning in either morning (AM) or afternoon (PM) time slots.

The TCDSB reserves the right to cancel a class. A preliminary list of cancelled courses will be available on the evening of **Thursday, June 27th, 2024**. It is the student's responsibility to check our website for a list of all cancelled classes.

Proof of registration and photo ID may be requested on the first day of in-person classes. Cancelled courses will be posted by Thursday, June 27th. We encourage all student to register before Tuesday, June 25th, 2024.

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory.
