Dear Principal Rivers, Staff, Parents/Guardians and Community Members of St. Pascal Baylon Catholic School:

We are pleased to be able to provide this update on the status of the planned improvements and renovations at St. Pascal Baylon Catholic School.

Planning and construction related to introducing Full-Day Kindergarten (FDK) is progressing on schedule. It is our hope that much of this extensive work will be completed by September, in time for students to move into these newly refurbished FDK rooms. However, it is expected that due to the complexity of the renovation, minor finishing details will need to be completed throughout the month of September during the evening hours and on the weekend.

Despite the challenges associated with this FDK retrofit work, providing a safe and fully functioning learning environment for our students is always our first priority. Please rest assured that we have prepared contingency plans in the event of any unforeseen construction delay.

These are very exciting times for our school as we have also received funding approval of \$10 million from the Ministry of Education to begin construction for a larger addition to our building that will include a modern gym. Preparations are currently underway with an anticipated construction start date of spring 2015. Every effort will be made to minimize disruption for our families by accommodating all students on site during the construction period.
