<p>Principal's Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wednesday, February 22, 2023, the TCDSB recognizes Pink Shirt Day, when we encourage everyone to continue <i>Walking with Christ with Hearts of Kindness and Love</i>, and to wear pink to symbolize that we do not tolerate bullying of any kind. With our belief in the worth and dignity of every person, we demonstrate living out the Gospel values of love, inclusion, compassion, and care for all. We raise awareness around healthy relationships and bullying prevention, including bullying due to homophobia and gender roles. <i>Community Engagement Policy and Guidelines Survey</i>: parents are asked to participate in the survey regarding proposed revisions. Survey link was shared via school messenger, deadline is March 27. <i>Student Voice Survey</i>: This survey focuses on collecting information on student perceptions of school (safety, bullying) and on students' cultural wealth (students' strengths and support(s) they receive from family, community, friends, school, faith, etc.) Student voice provides a measure of school climate to inform planning. Research Dept. will summarize the overall results for each school and for the Board. Survey to students in Grades 4 – 8 across all elementary schools. Surveys are anonymous, and students can skip questions they don't want to answer. The online survey is to be completed during class time, under teacher supervision, and should normally take no more than <u>30 minutes</u>; however, some students may require more time. Survey must be completed between Monday February 27 and Friday March 10, 2023. 25,000 was awarded for our Playground and Site Improvement application. Cooling center is in school library– completed Meeting Dates for Feb-June must be posted on website.
